Jim Hancock, Chairman of the Scott County Board of Supervisors announced today that County Attorney Bill Davis has submitted his letter of resignation to the County Auditor and the Board of Supervisors. In his letter, Mr. Davis said that he had been informed that obtaining the return of his license to practice law would take more time than he originally believed.

Chairman Hancock further stated that for the past twenty-nine years, Bill Davis has given the citizens of Scott County exceptional service that has been noted and admired statewide. His courage and leadership in the pursuit of justice for us all will be the standard for those who continue in his office. On behalf of all county residents, the Board sincerely thanks him and wishes him the best in his future.

The Board plans to take action next week to fill the County Attorney vacancy by appointing First Assistant County Attorney Mike Walton to the position.
