

IOWA POLL RESULTS

The Research 2000 Iowa Poll was conducted from Dec. 26 through Dec. 27, 2007. There were a total of 500 likely Democratic and 500 Republican caucus voters interviewed by telephone. The margin for error among each sample is 4.5%.
